- In addition to being targeted by for-profit hackers, cyber-espionage can also be a threat for institutions engaging in cutting-edge research










Security incidents in 2019: what data was exposed?

- Educational software company Pearson experienced a breach in 2018, exposing more than 13,000 school accounts, each containing the personal information of up to thousands of students³
- In 2018, the FBI issued a public service announcement about cybercriminals targeting online payroll accounts, pointing out the education industry as one of the most vulnerable sectors⁴


